Come up with a topic that interests you

You can't craft an essay without having a topic – so the first step is to figure out what you want to write on. If you've been assigned a topic, then it makes your job easier since you don't have to go through different ideas and pick one.

However, if the professor has given you the liberty of writing on your desired topic and you can get help from someone then [cheap essay writing service](#) can be your best choice, then you will need to brainstorm and explore different essay ideas.

When shortlisting ideas for your essay, make sure to go with the one that you find interesting and are passionate to write on. As this would make writing and research much more fun.

Research and gather information on your topic

When writing an essay, you aren't expected to come up with a paragraph or two. You have to write pages on information on your chosen topic, which you can't do until you have done your research and have sufficient knowledge.

Conducting research can be an overwhelming part of the writing process; you must stay focused and organized from the beginning. Go through different scholarly sources (academic journals, articles, websites, etc.) make sure that you only use authentic and credible sources.

Another trick is to cite the sources as you go. If you leave it till the end, you might miss one of the sources and get in trouble for plagiarism.

Keep the audience and subject in mind

The aim of your writing is to please the reader. No matter what kind of a paper or piece you are hoping to write, the focus always is the audience. Keep the target audience in mind and structure your essay accordingly. Use subject and level-appropriate language and jargons.

Understand the essay requirements

Students get assigned different types of essays; you need to determine the type of essay you are asked to write as the structure and other details differ for each of them. According to [best essay writing service](#), the thesis statement for an argumentative essay presents the main claim of the essay, whereas a narrative essay tells a story.

Develop an essay outline

Expert writers don't jump straight to writing – no one finishes a paper in a single go. To

make writing easier and more manageable, we break down the essay into different sections and determine the information that will be presented in each of them.

Consider this outline as a roadmap for your essay. It typically has three sections the introductory paragraph, essay body and conclusion.

Introduction

The essay introduction aims to grab the reader's interest and also educate them about the topic under discussion. An effective way to make the introduction interesting is to open with a hook sentence. A hook sentence can be an anecdote, question, quotation, statistic, or a personal story depending upon your essay and its topic.

Next, you must provide the reader with some background information on your topic. Just give them the necessary details to understand what the essay is about don't bombard them with information.

The last few lines of the introductory paragraph is dedicated to the thesis statement. A thesis statement is a summary of the main points and claims of the paper. It helps give the reader an idea of what to expect from the essay.

Body Paragraphs

A typical essay comprises three body paragraphs that hold the main points and information regarding the topic. Start each paragraph with a topic sentence, which is a preview of the points discussed in that particular paragraph. They act as transitions from paragraph to paragraph and give the reader an overview of the key points. Moreover, you need to present your supporting ideas in the body paragraphs and explain them using your opinions and authentic evidence.

If you want, you can add a small concluding statement for each paragraph; however, it isn't necessary.

Conclusion

The concluding paragraph is just as important as the introduction. Start by restating the

thesis and summing up the important points. Lastly, end with a thought-provoking statement, or suggest a course of action.

Write the final draft and edit

Using the essay outline and your research start working on your essay. Pay extra attention to the grammatical rules, spellings and citations.
