1. **Adding Original Ideas:** Instead of just adding and repeating what other people have done, include your personal and unique ideas in the essay. Find your own viewpoint and add it along with the supporting content.
1. **Using Plagiarism Checker:** Plagiarism checkers are great online tools to make sure that your content is absolutely clean from any sort of plagiarism. Check your work through Grammarly, Turnitin or any other reliable plagiarism checking tool before final submission.
